

**Terra Linda Elementary
School Community Council Meeting Minutes
October 10, 2019**

1. Celebrations:

- a. Fall Festival was a huge success \$6500 raised. Keep it spread out or condense?
- b. Lowest 25% of our school: Push in model for intervention to lesson gap of accessing curriculum. 61% of those 25% showed a years growth. We showed growth in lowest 25%, ESL students, and the general population. One of seven schools showed this growth.
- c. Added a “mindfulness” rotation to our rotation schedule- headed up by Mr. Martinez and social skills are being taught

4. Math Night Budget Approval:

- a. School community council can do one fundraiser. Money pays for math night, literacy night, and STEM night. Last Spring, the council approved to pay for Math Night kits.
- b. We still have \$2500 to pay for these nights.
- c. Mrs. Gorringer would like to spend \$20 per classroom to pay for an educational game for the classroom. That leaves us with \$1900 to pay for the nightly activities. Teachers will decide on one of five games purchased for the classrooms. The games will be played on Game night and then will go to the classrooms. (voted on \$600 to be spent on games for classrooms and was all affirmative.)

5. Parking Lot Update: Parking lot upgrade has been approved.

- a. It took 3.5 years to get it approved. This will be completed the summer of 2020. \$425,000 for an upgrade.
- b. Three plans will be presented to council and March will be the final decision.
- c. North Parking Lot will stay the same.
- d. Plans will be posted on the school website when they are finalized.

6. Reunification Process and Procedures:

- b. 125 students were reunified to parents in one hour.
- c. We need to have better activities to help manage students. A committee is working on that.
- d. We need to have a way of identifying ALL walking students and a plan for teachers to group those students.
- e. Some emergency contacts did not receive messages through skylert. Contact Lance Everill about Emergency Contact communications. How do we know the messages are received. Many of the emergency contacts were not notified.
- f. We will be having an additional reunification drill. Parents who volunteer to be a part of this will be involved.

Modules are being taught monthly and implemented in the classroom. Posters are hung in each room that say "What am I learning", "Why am I learning it", "How do I know that I've learned it."
