#### Terra Linda Elementary

- 2021-22 enrollment
  - 490 students as of 9/21
  - Pre school 4 sessions 2am x a week 2pm x a week
  - 2 full day 2 half day kindergarten classes
  - K-3 student to teacher ratio about 20
  - 4-6 student to teacher ratio about 25
- Focus for the year
  - Literacy
    - 95% WTR
  - Math
    - whole group, build RTI, Imagine Math K-3, IXL 4-6
  - Behavior
    - Behavior - PAWS learning walk, student of the month, positive phone calls, PAWS Tickets
  - Working as a team
    - Theme - Lego theme - We Build Together

- o Acadience Data
  - students tested BOY, MOY, EOY
  - Tested 445 students
    - 38% below proficiency
    - 13% approaching proficiency
    - 19% proficient
    - 30% above proficiency
  - School has a plan in place to help for this - 95% Walk to Read. Every child receives targeted intervention.

#### Land Trust

- Brief History
  - o Before Ms. Gorringer left it was proposed so use money for coaching cycles and Aides (Kinder, Math, Literacy)
    - 2021-22 Projected Amount \$61,347.00
      - Coaching Cycles -\$24,889.17
      - Kinder/Math/Lit Aides -\$36,457.83
      - Remaining Balance \$0
    - UPDATE - District gave budget to cover aides and coaching cycles are being paid out of another budget
- Allocation of funds 21-22
  - o Proposal to amend 2021 Land Trust Proposal - we are over 1 teacher. Use money to keep extra teacher. That would take the entire budget.
  - o Motion to approve
    - Rachelle Christensen - motioned to approve
    - Barbara Young seconded the motion
    - all approved motion
    - none opposed

  - o It has been motioned to approve the following
  - o New 2021-2022 Land Trust
    - 2021-22 projected amount \$63,166.52
    - Teacher -\$63,166.52
    - Remaining Balance \$0
