Celebrations

- New employees: Head Custodian Yvette, STEAM assistant Wendy has prevented cancelation of that program, Library Media assistant Wendy
- Walk to Read is working. Percentage of students ending the school year on grade level
 has increased substantially in all but 2 grades. Kids will be getting other extensions in
 fluency and comprehension to assist after they exit the Walk to Read phonics groups.
- We had great teacher retention this year.
- o We had an additional teacher coach provided by the state this year.
- Wellness Room opens Oct 1 for kids who need 10 minute brain breaks.
- Home visits went great; most of the feedback from parents and teachers was positive.
- This is the second year for STEAM and the kids love it.
- Kindergarten did the best they've ever done on end of year Acadience Testing.

• Focus for this year

- o RISE test scores have been stagnant at about 40-48% over the last few years.
- This year's focus is on Data and Rigor: Higher expectations, PLCs data driven, Focused PD based on needs, 2 coaching cycles per teacher this year.
- Interventions for below level kids and extensions for above level kids.
- o Teacher book study: 10 Mindframes for Visible Learning
- O How can we support teachers with the extra work?
 - Offer to help prep things for teachers

Land Trust

- \$65,903 this year + \$6,034 carryover = \$71,930
- Most will pay for new full-time certified PE teacher. Assistant PE teachers are less expensive but tend to be much less effective.
- o \$305.76 remaining will probably be used for Walk to Read materials.
- SCC Rules enforced to be consistent across the state
 - o Elementary & Jr. High
 - 4 parents & 2 employees including principal
 - Anyone else can visit, ask questions, and comment, but not vote
 - Elections every year
 - SCC Chair position was offered for vote. Shelly Christensen will remain chair with approval from all other SCC members.
 - David Bowers and Rachel Ferre will start 2 year terms now.
 - Barbara Young will start 1 year term now. Barbara & Shelly's positions will be up for voting next fall.
- SCC rules and orders of procedure read
- School grounds
 - Yvette will walk the grounds each morning to check for broken bottles, etc.
 - Yajaira requested WJPD do more rounds especially weekend evenings to reduce problems.
- Crosswalk

- Crossing guard was arriving late. Yajaira called supervisor, who required crossing guard to be on time (8:30am and 3:30pm).
- Concern with no crossing guard for 60-70 children coming at 8:15 for band, choir and breakfast.
 - Head crossing guard asked us not to allow PTA or employees to turn on crosswalk lights in the morning.
 - Parents are not allowed to assist as crossing guard
 - Yajaira has contacted district to look into options to keep children safe at that time.
- Reunification All backpacks updated and in classrooms.
- Barbara moved to close. Shelly seconded. All approved.
