Norms

• Kindergarten Registration

Open enrollment information was shared. We would like to have support by encouraging our parents to register their incoming kindergarten students. It is important that they register through Skyward so that it actually reflects our school numbers. So far we have had our kindergarten orientation and many that have reported that their students will be coming to TL but havent actually registered. SCC members will also encourage neighbors, friends to register.

• FTE 25-26

We had less FTE approved this year, as a result we had to make a decision to either keep using our Land Trust funds for the 25-26 to support a full time teacher. In order to do so we will keep a classroom teacher and hope we increase in enrollment to hire another full time teacher for PE. The feedback from our SCC was that they agreed to keep a full time classroom teacher to decrease classroom size and continue to support our student learning. If we cannot afford another full time teacher we will then support our PE program with two 17 hour ESP.

• RISE State Assessment Plan

We reviewed the RISE and Acadience state testing that will be happening in April and May. We spoke about the importance of encouraging students to do their best. We also discussed that we will be seeing cluster items on the test and how we will encourage motivation. Mr. Bowers suggested celebrating our 6th graders for all their hard work this year. He will contact RSL to see if we can visit their stadium.
