

## SCC Minutes- 5/29/26

Attendance: Kirt Davis, Sarah Southworth, Jordan Minter, Kelsey Christensen, Barbara Young

- The SCC started by reviewing norms and minutes from the previous meeting. Mr. Davis motioned to approve. Minter second.
- Mr. Davis reviewed the current staffing changes for the 26-27 school year. The changes were highlighted by K, 1st, and 3rd grade having two teachers instead of three. This was caused by lower enrollment.
- Mr. Davis discussed with SCC that Terra Linda will be eligible for Title I funding next school year and reviewed the basics of how that will impact the school. This is a recent change and more information will come from the school before the 26-27 school year. He mentioned that the school will be developing a plan on how to spend the Title I funds. It will be focused on providing support in math, ELA, and for behavior.
- SCC reviewed some of the end of year celebrations. Mr. Davis highlighted the following:
  - LEAP program had 1220 reading goals met, with 2nd grade having the most.
  - The State goal for Acadience is 65% and four grade levels met or exceed that. We had six grade levels at 60% or higher.
  - 16 Students exited the WIDA program.
- Mr. Davis reviewed the election process for next year. The election will take place at the beginning of the school year. Barbara Young, Edna Leal, and Sarah Southworth seats will be up for election. Jordan Minter and Kelsey Christensen will have 1 year left.
- Mr. Davis concluded the meeting by thanking the SCC for their work and support this year.
